The 30-unit Daybreak Cohousing project in North Portland is a couple of months from being completed. The future residents of the complex at 2525 N. Killingsworth St. will be able to live sustainably in a small community setting.

Green building practices include a solar water collector, rainwater collection for irrigation, heat recovery ventilation and hydronic floor heating. The common house will feature a great room in which residents can gather in groups and share meals, as well as a large kitchen and two bedrooms to accommodate guests. B&G Builders inc. is the general contractor and Schemata Workshop is the architect of the project.
